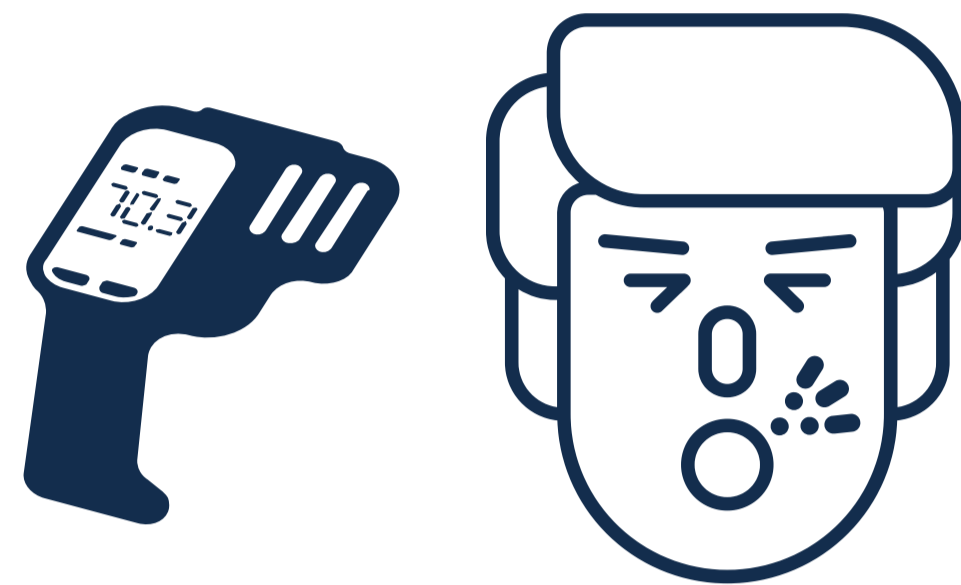

DAY OF APPOINTMENT

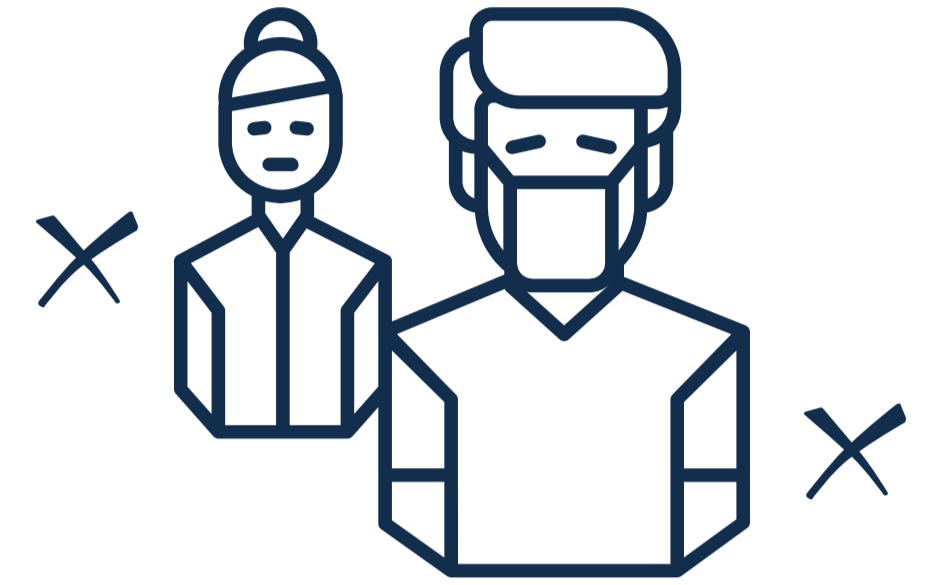
- ♥ Arrive on time, and alone for appointments to maintain physical distancing.*
- ♥ Complete pre-screening questionnaire prior to arrival (sent via text, email, or telephonically).

**exceptions for special populations*



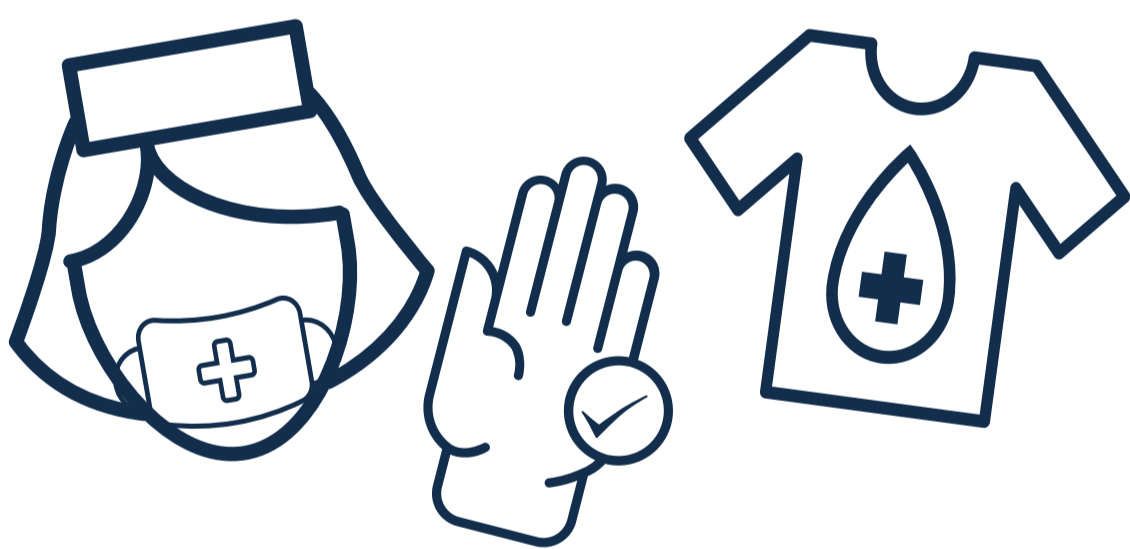
COLLECTIVE WELL-BEING

- ♥ Mandatory pre-screening questionnaire, digital temperature checks, pre-procedural rinse and hand washing will be required of all patients and team members.
- ♥ Per CDC/ADA, body temperatures exceeding 100.4 degrees will not be permitted to enter treatment rooms.



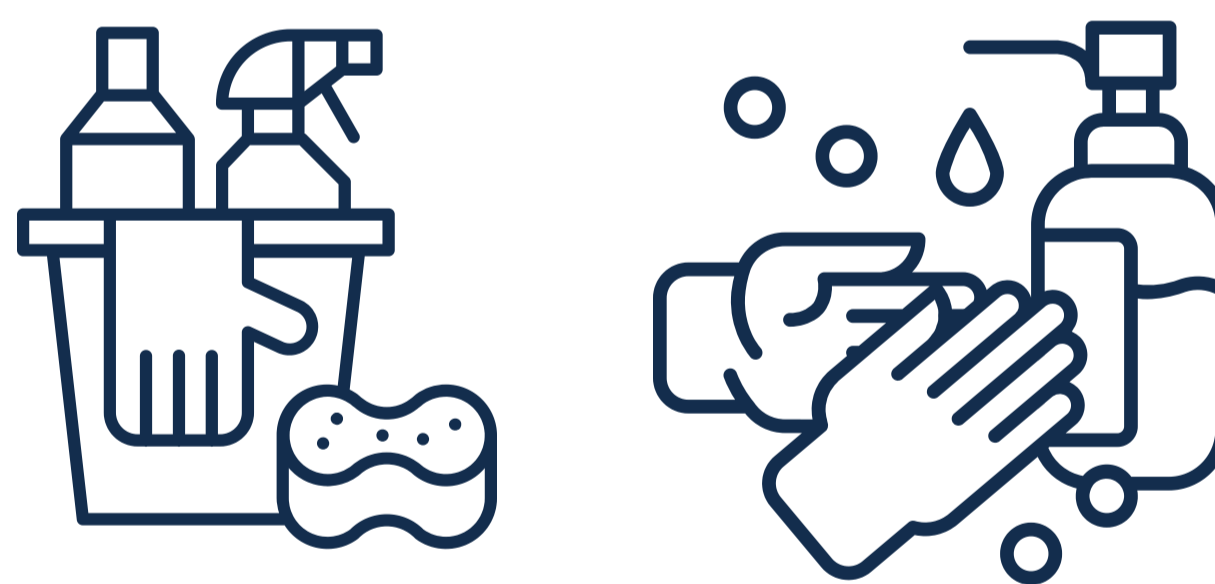
PHYSICAL DISTANCING

- ♥ Our newly remodeled lobby will adhere to physical distancing expectations.
- ♥ Appointments are cautiously scheduled to reduce the number of individuals in our office at any given time.



PROTECTIVE GEAR

- ♥ Our team is provided with Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), inclusive of facemasks, shields, gloves, and gowns.
- ♥ Patients are required to wear face coverings except while receiving treatment.



SANITIZATION

- ♥ Hand sanitizers are readily available throughout the office.
- ♥ Air Purification systems installed to maintain clean air all day.
- ♥ A fogging method is used to eliminate aerosols, ensuring germs and potential viruses are eradicated throughout the day.
- ♥ Deep-cleaning and sterilization protocols will continue overnight.

- ♥ In the event there is a confirmed case of COVID-19 at our office, we will notify you.
- ♥ We ask that you notify our office manager if you test positive within 14 days of your last appointment.
